

Additional Tire Pressure email notification via OnStar®

About one year ago, I purchased a new 2009 Chevrolet® Silverado 2500 Heavy Duty truck with all the bells and whistles including the OnStar® navigation package. To my pleasant surprise, we began receiving a vehicle diagnostic & health report via email every month that included tire pressure!

In addition to the TPMS alert system embedded in the vehicle that immediately warns the driver of any tire that is 25% below the recommended tire pressure, the OnStar® report provides an additional tire pressure notification via email once per month (Tire Pressure diagnostic from email shown below).

It only took about 90 days (first cold snap of winter) before my wife received a TPMS warning light icon in the truck. I was very pleased that evening when she asked me to air up the tires on the truck knowing that her safety no longer depended on me remembering to check the air in her tires. Shortly thereafter, we also received the monthly OnStar® email notifying us that all four tires in the truck were low on air.

TPMS has definitely been a peace-of-mind feature for my wife and I, knowing our new truck will notify the driver of a low tire pressure scenario.

 **Tire Pressure: Low (Add Air)**

- One or more tires require immediate attention. Inflate them to the values shown below as soon as you can.
- Recommended tire pressure - Front: 60 psi, Rear: 72 psi

Left Front: Low, 48 psi				Right Front: Low, 50 psi
Left Rear: Low, 56 psi				Right Rear: Low, 55 psi
